



OSCIL's PERSONAL CARE ATTENDANT (PCA) PROGRAM

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Do you or someone you know require assistance with daily living activities such as bathing, dressing, shopping, meal preparation, or transportation in order to attend school, work, or be independent in the community?

Ocean State Center for Independent Living's (OSCIL) PCA program can assist eligible Rhode Islanders by providing funds for a Personal Care Attendant!

TO BE ELIGIBLE

Be self-directed (manage timesheets, hiring/termination of PCAs, etc.) and able to advocate for yourself and your needs.

Not receiving services from the State's Long Term Care program.

Have a significant need for PCA supports and services.

Not eligible for other home-based support service programs.

Must be within these income guidelines:

- 1 person living at home - no greater than \$3,856.03/month*
- 2 people living at home - no greater than \$5,660.00/month*

Liquid assets must be under \$20,000, including but not limited to cash and bank accounts.

Income limits include income from SSI, SSDI, unemployment, pensions, rental income, and other sources.
