



OSCIL's DigiAge Technology Program

Through a partnership with the Office of Healthy Aging (OHA), OSCIL is helping consumers with disabilities learn how to shop, bank, take part in Tele-Health sessions, and socialize through technology and training:

- **Shopping:** OSCIL may offer training and assistance to consumers with disabilities on how to shop online or use assistive technology and apps.
- **Banking:** OSCIL can help consumers with disabilities access and manage their finances through technology.
- **Tele-Health Sessions:** This might involve helping consumers set up and use video conferencing software and connect with healthcare providers from the comfort of their homes.
- **Socializing:** OSCIL can assist individuals with disabilities in connecting with others and socializing online.

Individuals with disabilities may apply for technology and training through OSCIL's DigiAge Technology Program. This includes devices such as:
