

OSCIL's PERSONAL CARE ATTENDANT (PCA) PROGRAM

Do you or someone you know need assistance with activities such as bathing, dressing, shopping, meal prep or transportation in order to attend school keep a job, or otherwise be independent in the community?

Ocean State Center for Independent Living's (OSCIL) mission is to provide a range of Independent Living Services to enhance, through self-direction, the quality of life of persons with disability and to promote integration into the community.

OSCIL has a small program for consumers who are not eligible or are over income for State programs including, Medicaid and the cost-share program.



To be eligible, you **MUST** be:

- Self-directed (able to take part in the program and manage PCA's ie: timesheets, hiring / terminating, etc and able to advocate for your self and your needs.)
- Not on or eligible for the State Medicaid program
- Not eligible for any other home-based support service programs
- Must be within these income guidelines:
 - 1 person living at home – no greater than \$2742 monthly*
 - 2 people living at home – no greater than \$4113.00 monthly*
- Liquid assets must be under \$20,000 (examples are cash, bank accounts, 401K that can be drawn on and others.)

**Monthly income may be from SSI, SSDI, employment, pensions, rental income or other.*
